Billings County, located in the midst of the Badlands is comprised of 1152 square miles with approximately 52% of the lands owned by the State and Federal government. The main industries are ranching/agriculture, tourism and oil. The population is approximately 890 people and in the 1990 census the population was 1108. Billings County has many attractions and historical sites. Theodore Roosevelt National Park (South Unit) is located in the county and also the Cowboy Hall of Fame and a museum. Other attractions are the Medora Musical and the Chateau DeMores.

The Recorder's office has digitized images, complete indexing and exporting from 2000 to present. Documents may be found by book and page up until around October of 2004 and then we switched over to using the document number, starting with document number 122053. We are back scanning as time allows. All documents have been imaged back to 1965 and you can search by document number or book and page (the only data for these documents are the instrument type, document date, recording date, document number, book and page numbers)

Corner Records:

All records have been scanned and indexed and can be searched by legal description on NDRIN.
