We currently have data and images of Pembina County documents dating back to 1/01/2003 available on the NDRIN site.

Our office hours are 8-5 Monday through Friday.

Summer hours are 8-4:30 Memorial Day through Labor Day.

We are closed on all major holidays.

If you are searching for Corner Records in our county they are recorded as Monument Records. (See separate link to Monument Record Index list)

Government Lots are indexed by the ¼ ¼ section where they are located.

Plat Maps have been entered on Pembina County. Search "Plat" and you will find all maps. The "Addition" has been indexed as Grantor and the "City" has been indexed as the Grantee.

There are a few randomly scanned-in documents prior to 2003. At some point in the future there will be at least the last conveying document scanned into NDRIN concerning each parcel.

Pembina County was officially formed on August 12, 1867, the first county in the State of North Dakota. The first courthouse was built in 1881 in Pembina City, but in 1911, the county seat was moved to Cavalier City. The present courthouse was completed in 1913.
